Happy Soles Ministry

April was another slow month due to all the restrictions with Covid-19. Some of our families have suffered from layoffs due to the restrictions, but most of them continue to get their government checks. We continue providing food baskets to our needy church families while keeping 6 feet separation. We have delivered baskets for a few of the families that do not have transportation. Our annual Easter food baskets are still delayed. Most likely, they will get delivered later this month when conditions become more favorable/safe. We have decided to cancel all our summer groups this year. This decision was made partly to give the groups plenty of notice and partly because we do not know when it will be safe and prudent to host again.

Corvid-19 Ministry Changes

The Happy Church services are available on Facebook each Sunday. The response has been surprisingly good, and we are reaching people who have never attended before. The children and teen ministries are also still cancelled. We continue to do 5 to 10-minute devotionals every day. The devotionals are being rotated between Randy, Jason, and John, with Mike preaching for the Sunday Service. We have had a good response on the devotionals as well, with favorable comments from as far away as Korea and Japan - the HC "global outreach".

Breathitt County School buses were delivering breakfasts and lunches to all students that requested them. I am sure this was extremely helpful for many of them. The end of the school year was May 7th. After May 7th, the lunches were stopped, so pray that children get access to some free meals. With the Tabor's and Jacobson's having foster sons now, it has been interesting tutoring 7th and 8th grade boys. I am not sure who was happier

when school ended this year - the adult tutors or the boys. School teachers are definitely underpaid!!
