We typically have 50-70 kids in K-6th grades attend the Jackson Campus for Kids' City. Oakdale Christian School teens continue to join us and are actively involved in all aspects of this ministry.

The teens are taking leadership roles in many of the Happy Church ministries. Trevor Fugate is now a permanent member of the worship team. His singing skills have been honed for many years by lessons from Connie and Mike. Connie continues to invest many hours in developing our teens into accomplished singers. Some of the teens are leading the worship for teen night and are also a big help for Kids' City. At the Clayhole Campus, teens take care of almost the whole program. There are instances where I have taken notice of some of the fruits of the teen ministry. The Bible Quizzing teens recently went to the bowling center to bowl and have some pizza as a reward for their hard work. As we were getting ready to leave, one of the employees commented to us that we had a great group. He said this, not only due to their good behavior, but also because the cleaned up after themselves and put everything away. After one of the recent teen nights, the kids were singing worship songs as we drove them home. That was a special moment.

Clayhole Campus

Building improvements at the Clayhole Campus continue to move forward. Bob Sidwell and Scott Thompson, from Eastside Grace in Columbus, came down in January to continue the work on the new addition.
