Flood Cleanup and Repairs

There are two remaining projects from the flood damage. The Abbey, the guest trailer behind the barn, was torn down by a team from Eastside Grace and Ashland Grace. They then started to rebuild it, partly on the old trailer frame. They also extended it 8 feet wider than it was before. Before they left, they had it framed, wrapped, and windows and doors installed, as well as tar papered. An approaching Ida made it obvious we needed to get a roof on ASAP.
