Vick Smith and Pastor John took on a project in the community. A family purchased a rent-to-own house that needed extensive work. Vick, an experienced plumber, roughed in the plumbing. Vick did 98% of the work, while John handed him tools and ran to the store to pick up parts. The original sewer lines were all cast iron and were not easy to cut through.

With Thanksgiving coming up, Centerville Grace and others are raising money for the Thanksgiving baskets. Due to Covid, we had a decrease in the number of food baskets needed this year. Eightytwo is still a large number to prepare and deliver. It was really difficult getting turkeys this year, but the Lord came through for us!

To get ready for Christmas, we had to get pictures of children and their wish lists for Christmas. It was difficult this year due to the kids' ministry being shut down for a few weeks from the covid spike. Connie, Chris, and Tiffany had to go to many of the homes who were not reachable by phone or through the social network. This year, 194 kids were sponsored for Chistmas presents, which will need to be delivered to the their homes. Ho Ho Ho! It is turning cold, so we are currently trying to get ready for the winter coat give-a-way, including hats and gloves for the kids. Each year, we have coats left over, because it is hard to guess what sizes are needed. The coats left from last year got ruined in the flood, which means we are starting from scratch and our needs are much greater this year.
