After the last batch of donations, we sent each kid home with a loaf of bread. Some of the donated items weren't in our standard food box, so they were added as a bonus. The donated food items are also used to feed the kids. We are getting ready for our Easter Food Boxes again this year. We estimate that we will pass out close to 100 boxes on April 16th. Eastside Christian from Milford, OH, will come down to help distribute the baskets.
